AURORA AWARD 2009 GOLD WINNER

The Aurora Award is an international competition designed to recognize excellence in the film and video industries specifically targeted at nonnational commercials, regional or special interest entertainment, and corporate-sponsored film and video. Entries are judged based on creativity, message effectiveness, and technical excellence. The PCOR Partnership documentary "Out of the Air – Into the Soil," premiered by Prairie Public Broadcasting in September 2008, was a 2009 Gold Winner.

COMMUNICATOR 15TH ANNUAL AWARD OF EXCELLENCE 2009

The Communicator Awards is the leading international award program honoring creative excellence for communications professionals and is one of the largest awards of its kind on the world. The Communicator Awards is sanctioned and judged by the International Academy of the Visual Arts, an invitation-only body consisting of top-tiered professionals from media communications, advertising, creative, and marketing firms. The Award of Excellence, the highest honor, is awarded to those with outstanding communication ability, which puts them among the best in the field. The PCOR Partnership received two awards in this category for its documentaries "Reducing Our Carbon Footprint" (premiered by Prairie Public Broadcasting in April 2008) and "Out of the Air – Into the Soil" (premiered by Prairie Public Broadcasting in September 2008).

CSLF RECOGNITION AWARD

The Carbon Sequestration Leadership Forum (CSLF) is a ministerial-level international climate change initiative focused on the development of improved, cost-effective technologies for the separation and capture of carbon dioxide (CO₂) for its transport and long-term, safe storage. CSLF promotes collaborative research, development, and demonstration projects involving technologies that reflect member priorities as well as promote awareness and champion legal, regulatory, financial, and institutional environmental initiatives conducive to such technologies. The CSLF Technical Group evaluates all projects proposed for recognition and recommends those that meet the evaluated criteria to the Policy Group. The Fort Nelson CCS Project received CSLF recognition in October 2009 in London, and the Zama Acid Gas EOR, Sequestration, and Monitoring Project received CSLF recognition in March 2007 in Paris.



IOGCC CHAIRMAN'S STEWARDSHIP AWARD – ENVIRONMENTAL PARTNERSHIP

The Interstate Oil and Gas Compact Commission (IOGCC) is a multistate government agency that promotes conserving and developing domestic oil and natural gas in responsible, environmentally sound ways while protecting health, safety, and the environment. The Chairman's Stewardship Award is given in four categories: energy education, small company, large company, and environmental partnership, the category in which the PCOR Partnership won in November 2008. The award represents IOGCC's highest honor for exemplary efforts in environmental stewardship.
